

Review lesson 1 – 12 (We are Muslims)

1. Sadaqah – giving charity
 - A practice of helping to those in need
 - Sadaqah doesn't refer only to money giving, any simple deed that helps someone else in anyway.
 - For example, smiling is a charity. Removing an obstacle from a path of someone's else is a charity.
 - Giving Sadaqah strengthens our faith, and increases it further
 - A monetary Sadaqah should be given to the poor who can't make a living themselves.
2. Sustainer – One who provides and take cares
 - Allah (swt) is the Sustainer of the entire universe.
3. Iman – believing and having faith in Allah (swt)
 - Know Iman Mufassal (pg. 42, with meaning)
4. Fard – compulsory acts (a must do for Muslims)
 - Some examples: obedience to Allah (swt) and Rasullullah (saw), 5 pillars of Islam (review), making wudu before salat, etc.
5. Sunnah – actions and teachings of Rasulullah (saw)
 - We've talked many examples in class.
 - Saying morning dua and washing hands the first thing in the morning
 - Saying Bismillah, Alhumdullilah, InshaAllah, ...
 - Putting on and off shoes (on – start from right, off – start from left)
 - Sleeping on your right side
 - Sitting when eating/drinking, starting with Bismillah
 - Cleanliness, etc.
6. Ahadith (plural – Hadith) - sayings of Rasulullah (saw)
 - Know the difference: Sunnah – actions, Hadith – sayings
7. Seeking knowledge is a Sunnah
 - Doa for seeking knowledge – Rabbi zidni'ilma (my Lord, increase me in my knowledge)
8. Some of the 99 names of Allah
 - Al- Bari – the Giver of life
 - Al- 'Adl – the Just
 - Al- Hafiz – the Protector
 - Al- Wadud – the Most Loving
 - Al- Rahman – the Most Gracious
 - Al – Raheem – the Most Merciful

9. Ibadah – forms of worship

- Five daily prayers
- Read the Quran
- Zikr – remembering Allah (swt)
- Follow Sunnah

10. Ihsan – worshipping Allah (swt) as if you see Him. If you cannot do this, then know He sees you.

11. Angels – Allah’s creations, made out of light, always listen to Allah’s command, have assigned duties. (they are NOT human)

- Jibril – brings Allah’s message to Prophets
- Israfil – blows As-Sur on the day of Judgement
- Makail – arranges the rainfall
- Kiraman Katibin – sits on right and left shoulder, writing down good and bad deeds
- Izrail – the death angel
- Munkar & Nakir – question us after we have died and been put in the graves

12. Prophets – are special human beings (NOT angels, NOT sons of Allah) sent by Allah (swt) to teach people and guide them to the STRAIGHT path

- Messengers – are Prophets to whom Allah’s books were given
- Rasulullah (saw) is the Seal of the Prophets – Khatam un-Nabiyin

13. Books of Allah (Wahi)

- Suhuf – to Prophet Ibrahim (as)
- Tawrat – to Prophet Musa (as)
- Zabur – to Prophet Dawud (as)
- Injil – to Prophet Isa (as)
- Quran – to Prophet Mohammad (saw), Allah swt promised that the Quran will not be lost.

14. Know these words

- Tawhid – Oneness of Allah (swt)
- Tawakkul – trust in Allah (swt)
- Justice – we judge people with truth, wisdom, and understanding
- Bedouin – someone who lives in the desert and travels from place to place
- Sayyiduna – Master
- Adhab – manners, behavior, etiquette
- Khalifah – a person who governs an Islamic state
